If you are ready to join the SeaDevils for a great ScubaJam, keep reading for more detailed information about the event.

What it Costs

Event fees are:

- \$227.50 for scuba divers
- \$132.50 for non-divers
- \$81.75 for dive professionals
- \$265 group pre-registration deposit will be paid by SeaDevil

What You Get

For that fee, divers get:

- Commemorative T-shirt & event patch
- Welcome packet for youth only
- Leadership baseball cap for adults
- Entry to Lake Phoenix for the weekend (Fri-Mon)
- 3 nights of camping (Fri-Sun)
- 4 days of diving (Fri-Mon)
- Unlimited air fills on 1 tank for the weekend (tank rental not included)
- Fri evening meal, Sat & Sun breakfast, lunch & dinner.

Non-divers get camping and meals.

Your Responsibilities

SeaDevil will pay the group registration deposit and provide dive pros and group leaders. Parents are responsible for individual fees as well as transporting and supervising their young divers and non-diving children. Each person must provide their own tent, sleeping bag, dive gear and other personal gear.

Gear Rentals

For the four-day weekend, Lake Phoenix will offer a special tank rental rate of \$58.50. (Remember, it will be a busy weekend at the lake, but ample tank rentals will be available and instant tank exchange saves time.) It's also best to rent your weights there at 10 cents per pound per day.

Dive Connections will offer a special rate on rentals for the **whole weekend**. For \$75, divers can get all the following:

- Regulator set with SPG, compass and computer
- BCD
- Wetsuit, hood and gloves

This compares very favorably with Lake Phoenix, which will charge its normal rate *each day* for:

•	Full wetsuit (3mm or 7mm)	\$ 24.50
•	BCD	\$ 30.50
•	Regulator with SPG console	\$ 39.00
•	Regulator with computer console	\$ 55.00
•	Hood	\$ 8.00
•	Gloves	\$ 8.50

Dive Lights

Every diver who wants to take part in the Saturday night dive will need to have both primary and backup dive lights. Dive Connections is working on a package to help divers that need to equip themselves ahead of ScubaJam. Lake Phoenix also have a limited number of lights available at their shop.

Late Arrival

Lake Phoenix closes at 6:00 pm. If you will be arriving after 6:00 pm, please register on the Lake Phoenix late arrival page to arrange late entry. Late arrival registration is available 48 hours before your planned arrival date. For ScubaJam late arrivals on Friday Aug 30th, you can register starting Wednesday Aug 28th.

How to Sign Up

You can sign up for the SeaDevil ScubaJam group, by contacting Michael Durland.

Dive Connections will collect your registration fee and tank rental and forward it to Lake Phoenix. **NOTE: This is a change from last year's procedure.** Payment can be made by stopping by the dive center located at 1754 Timberwood Blvd, Charlottesville or by giving them a call at 434-964-9200.

Waivers

ScubaJam participants need to complete two waivers – (1) one for the ScubaJam event and (2) Lake Phoenix's normal waiver, completed annually by all divers at the lake. There will be some repetition between these processes. An electronic signature is required on each of the waivers, so completing them on a mobile device is a little simpler.

If any of the links in this document don't work, simply go to www.lakephoenixva.com, and scroll down to the bottom of the home page to see the various links.

- 1) ScubaJam event waiver: complete the online <u>ScubaJam Waiver</u> by clicking on the yellow box that applies to you:
 - <u>ScubaJam Certified Divers</u>
 - ScubaJam non-Diver
 - ScubaJam Dive Pro

Most of the boxes and entry fields are self-explanatory. For our specific group:

- Individual / Group Selection, use the drop-down box to choose SeaDevil Youth
- For **Group leader**, type in **Michael Durland**
- If you're an adult, please consider using the "Adult Diver volunteering for:" drop-down menu at the end of the READ CAREFULLY section to volunteer to help with:
 - Cylinder movement
 - Kitchen assistant
 - o Ranger, in water [you must be at least a certified Rescue Diver]
 - Dock Master Assistant
 - Registration
 - Games, in water Sat

Note: If you find this is a mandatory field, simply click on an activity - you're not committed.

- In the line immediately following, type in the days and times you will be available to assist.
- When you check the "Electronic Signature Consent" box and click "Agree To This Document" at the bottom of the registration, you will be taken to a YouTube video that acquaints you with Lake Phoenix's rules, facilities and procedures.
- After you watch the video, you'll receive an email to confirm your E-signature on the ScubaJam waiver. Just click on the box in the message labeled Confirm Email Address.
- Then you'll receive another email confirming that your ScubaJam Waiver has been sent to all parties of the agreement. There will be a link for you to print out your own signed copy.

This waiver is only for ScubaJam; you must also complete the normal Lake Phoenix waiver for the current year.

- 2) Lake Phoenix annual waiver, click on the <u>Waivers</u> link at the bottom of the home page. As with the ScubaJam Waiver, click on the yellow box that applies to you. Even non-diving visitors must complete the waiver.
 - After reading the **LAKE PHOENIX STANDARD SCUBA DIVING PRACTICES**, enter your initials at the bottom of the page.
 - Then, you'll click on a box to choose whether the person diving is an **Adult** or a **Minor** and click on the **Continue** box.
 - Complete the blanks that appear and click on the **Click to Sign** box. Type in your signature and then click on the **Accept Signature** box.
 - Complete the next of blanks that appear and, under **READ CAREFULLY**, use the drop-down box to identify the agency under which the diver is certified. Read the terms of the waiver and click the boxes that indicate you've read, understand and accept the agreement and consent to using your electronic signature. At the bottom, click the **Agree To This Document** box.
 - You will now be redirected to the same video that you watched after completing the ScubaJam Waiver.
 - After you finish watching the video, you'll receive an email from Lake Phoenix. Click on the
 Confirm Email Address box and another email will confirm the agreement and provide a link to
 download a copy of the waiver for your own records.

SeaDevil Registration & Release

All participants of the SeaDevil Youth ScubaJam group (youths and adults), must download, complete and submit the printable <u>SeaDevil Youth Annual Club Application</u>. All participants must fully complete and sign this document. A parent must sign this in addition to their youth(s). Any parent that is diving should also initial the boxes and sign their youth's document. This will cover all family divers; there's no need to complete a separate form for each family member. Once you've completed and signed the form, you can scan it and email it to <u>Dive Connections</u> or snail mail it to:

Though SeaDevil membership is not a requirement for this event, we urge you to become a SeaDevil club member. Your \$54 annual dues (\$35 for each additional family member to a maximum of \$119 per family) gives you:

- \$30 savings on Diver Days at Lake Phoenix (May October) member cost is \$25
- \$10 admission to pool dives (Nov April) non-Member cost is \$25
- 50% off air fills and Nitrox fills
- 30% off SeaDevil logo merchandise
- 10% discount off annual gear service
- ... and more

Joining the SeaDevils for the Diver Days gives youth members four opportunities to practice in the lake (May, June, July and August) before ScubaJam. If you're already a member and need to pay your 2024 dues, you can do so at any club event, at Dive Connections or on the web.
